OFFSHORE GUYANA

On March 15, 2019, Esso Exploration & Production Guyana Ltd (EEPGL) will recommence a drilling operation at the Longtail-1 well site, within the **Stabroek Block** of the Guyana Maritime Zone. A well testing operation will then be undertaken during the period March 28-April 12, 2019. This operation will involve intermittent flaring from Drill Ship **STENA CARRON**.

This operation will also incorporate the use of the undermentioned vessels that will display the international signal for vessels engaged in such activities.
