DEMERARA RIVER

The Maritime Administration Department hereby notifies all vessels calling Port Georgetown and those in Port Georgetown, that the Guyana Power & Light (**GPL**) will commence Submarine Cable laying and Pile Driving activities across the Demerara River from Princess Street Outfall Georgetown to Vreed en Hoop Ferry Stelling on June 08, 2019 for a period of seven (7) days.

This operation would be conducted by utilizing the undermentioned vessels;

M/T RED DAWN

D/B GAICO MARINE

The submarine cable would be buried along the following coordinates:

During this period, four (4) wooden piles would be installed within this restricted area and would be fitted with lights showing the following characteristics FL Q Y (Quick Flashing Yellow Light)

The above mentioned vessels would be on site for the duration of this exercise and mariners are therefore, warned to navigate with caution when in this area
