The Maritime Administration Department (MARAD) hereby notifies that the Chart Datum or minimum depth in the Demerara Main Ships Channel is currently **5.2 metres**; (hence the rise of tide must be added for determination of the sailing draft of ALL vessels.)

Vessels transiting the channel must have adequate Under Keel Clearance (UKC), taking the following in consideration;

- Presence of sling mud in the channel
- Specific characteristics of each vessel
