
The *Maritime Administration Department (MARAD)* hereby notifies all vessels operating and/ or anchoring within the Harbour of Georgetown, that there are two Submarine Cables that cross the Demerara River in the following areas:

- 1. From Princess Street Outfall, Georgetown to Vreed-en -Hoop Ferry Stelling;
- 2. From GPL Berth Kingston to Vreed-en-Hoop.

These submarine cables were laid along the following coordinates:

Vessels are, therefore, prohibited from anchoring in close proximity to these cables, that is to say, anchoring should be conducted at a minimum distance of 200 metres when the vessel rides on her anchor.
