

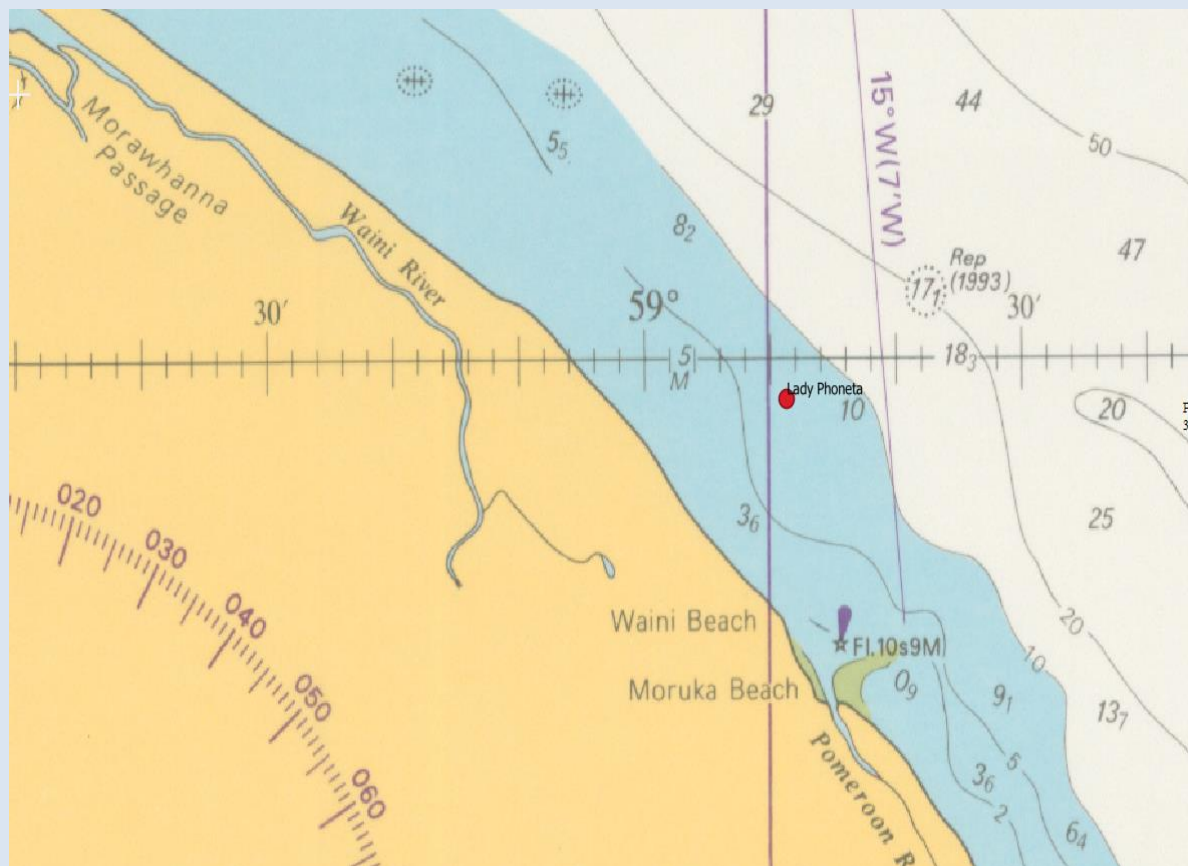

NOTICE TO MARINERS**

No. 059(2021) Guyana

POMEROON RIVER MOUTH

A Cargo vessel “**Lady Phoneta**” has reportedly sank some **ten (10)** nautical miles off the coast of Guyana in the vicinity of the Pomeroon river mouth, in a charted depth of 7.7 meters (as shown on BA Chart 572); in the approximate position:

Latitude (N)	Longitude (W)	Remarks
07° 57'.000	058° 49'.000	WGS 84 Datum

The wreck lies some twenty (20) nautical miles with bearing 170.37° T from the mouth of the Pomeroon River and is fully submerged at Low Spring Tides.

Mariners are, therefore, warned to keep clear of this wreck; and navigate with caution in this area.
