The *Maritime Administration Department (MARAD)* wishes to advise that five (5) **Virtual Aid to Navigation (AtoNs)** were established within the Georgetown Harbour, marking the Guyana Power & Light “**Kingston to Vreed en Hoop**” and “**Princess Street Outfall to Vreed en Hoop**” Submarine Power Cables.

These virtual AtoNs would transmit the necessary information to vessels equipped with the Electronic Chart Display & Information Systems (EDCIS) and/or Automatic Identification System (AIS).

The characteristics of these Virtual AtoNs are as follows:
