On January 01, 2022, CGX Energy Guyana will continue exploration drilling operations in Kawa -1 well site, within the Corentyne Block of the Guyana's Exclusive Economic Zone.

This operation is scheduled to conclude on **February 05, 2022**, and will incorporate the use of the *PSV Breaux Tide and OSV Polaris* which will display the international signal for vessels engaged in such activities.

The area is situated approximately 91.22 nautical miles (168.93 kilometers) from the Coast of Guyana, and covers an area of 4.40 square nautical miles (15.09 square kilometers), bounded by the following coordinates:
