All ships/watercrafts intending to transit the Berbice main ship's channel are advised that, the Rear Beacon is currently under construction, and as such there is no structure with light to aid safe passage of vessel during the period of darkness (night). This will result in the closure of this channel during the nocturnal period, with transiting permitted only during daylight. All vessel are advised to navigate with extreme caution when navigating within the limits of the channel and have due regards to the aforementioned situation.
