**No. 074 (2022) Guyana**

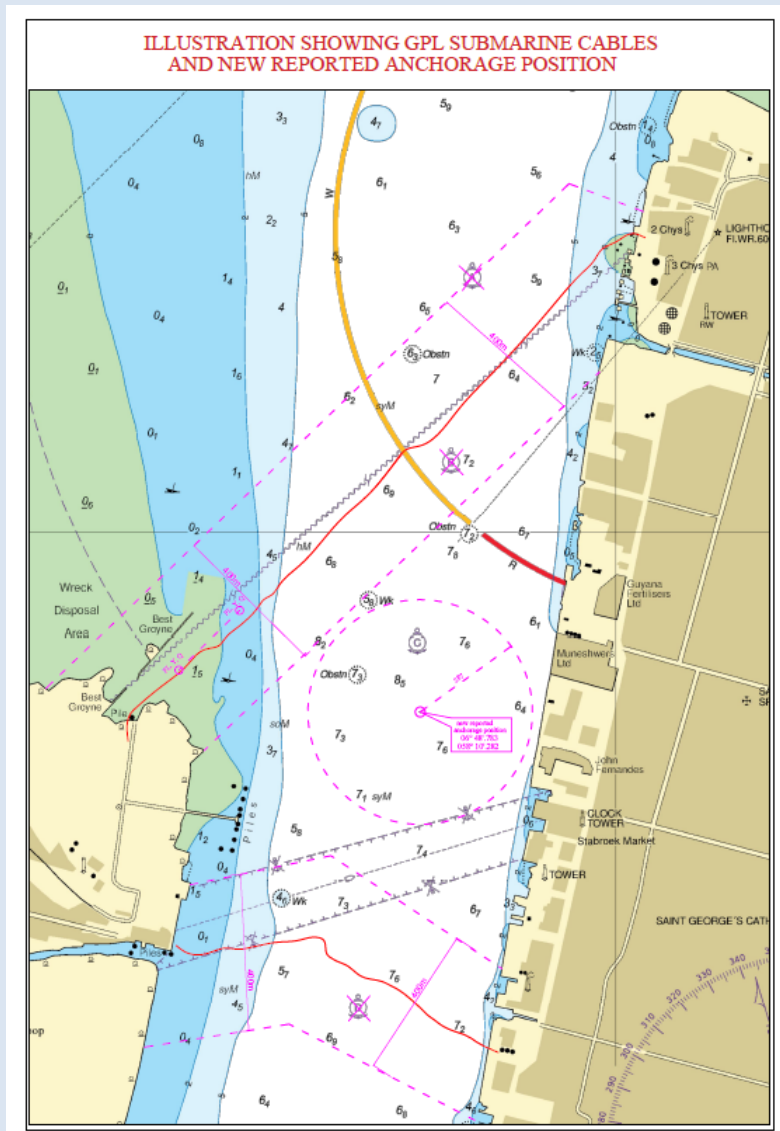
#### DEMERARA RIVER

The *Maritime Administration Department (MARAD)* hereby notifies all vessels operating and/ or within the Harbour of Georgetown, that the Guyana Power Light Company (**GPL**) has two submarine power cables laid between GPL Kingston to Vreed-en-Hoop and GPL Vreed en Hoop to Princess Street Outfalls.

These submarine cables were laid along the following coordinates:

Vessels are therefore prohibited from anchoring in close proximity to these cables, that is to say, anchoring should be conducted at a minimum distance of 200 metres when the vessel rides on her anchor.

All vessels are also required to communicate with the Georgetown Lighthouse on VHF Ch. 16; all movements within port and submit their crew list prior to departure.
