**NOTICE TO MARINERS**

**No. 075 (2022) Guyana**

**DEMERARA RIVER**

A vessel “**Tug Adam A**” has sunk some **five (5)** nautical miles south from the Demerara Harbour Bridge in the vicinity of the East Bank of the Demerara River, in a charted depth of 2.0 meters (as shown on BA Chart 519); in the position:

<b>Latitude (N)</b>	<b>Longitude (W)</b>	<b>Remarks</b>
06° 40'.755	058° 11'.175	WGS 84 Datum

The wreck lies some 5.5 nautical miles with bearing 183° T from the Demerara Harbour Bridge Retractor Span, and the Superstructure is visible at High Tides.

Mariners are therefore warned to keep clear of this wreck and navigate with caution in this area.
