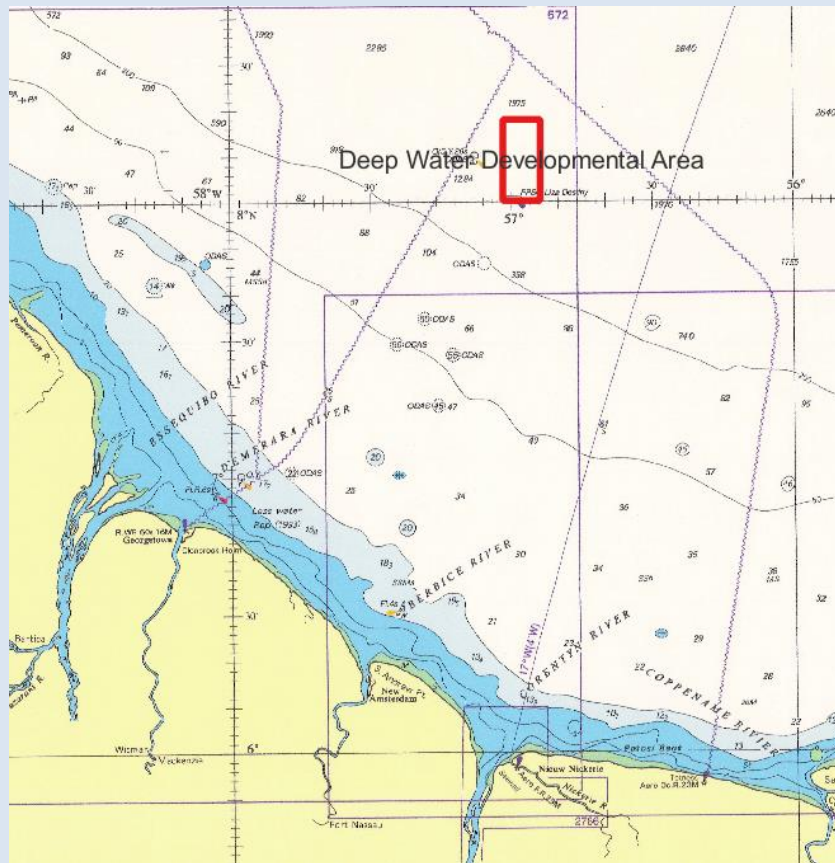
On *January 01, 2023* *Esso Exploration & Production Guyana Ltd (EEPGL)* will continue Deep Water Development operations in Liza Field, within the **Stabroek Block** of Guyana's Exclusive Economic Zone.

This exercise is scheduled to conclude on **December 31, 2023** and will incorporate the use of the undermentioned vessels, which will display the international signal for vessels engaged in such activities:

- **OSV Seacor Congo**
- **OSV Seacor Amazon**
- **OSV Seacor Demerara**
- **OSV Emily Day McCall**
- **OSV Seacor Murray**
- **Seacor Tarahumara**
- **OSV Seacor Mixteca**

The developmental area is situated approximately 102.27 nautical miles (189.4 kilometers) off the Coast of Guyana and covers an area of 136.8 square nautical miles (469.3 square kilometer); bounded by the following coordinates:
