APPROACHES TO DEMERARA RIVER

The Maritime Administration Department (MARAD) hereby advises all vessels in the vicinity of the Demerara Light, and approaches to the Demerara River that the Guyana Defence Force (GDF) will be engaged in a multi-nation military exercise (Exercise Trade winds) commencing on July 14, 2023.

This exercise is scheduled to conclude on July 28, 2023, and will incorporate the below military vessel Arm Veracruz which will be arriving on July 13, 2023 and departing on July 28, 2023.

This military vessel will anchored in an area bounded by the following coordinates:
