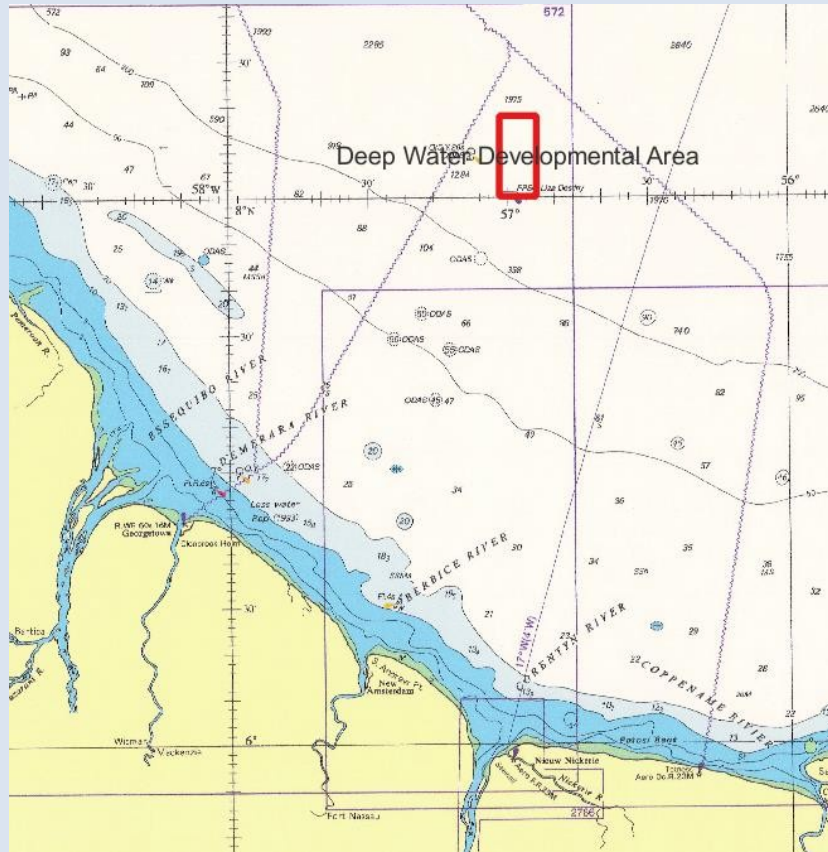
**OFFSHORE GUYANA**

*ExxonMobil Guyana Ltd (EMGL)* will continue Deep Water Development operations in Liza Field, within the **Stabroek Block** of Guyana's Exclusive Economic Zone.

This exercise is scheduled to conclude on **December 31, 2023** and will incorporate the use of the undermentioned vessel **Tug SD GRACE**, which will display the international signal.

The developmental area is situated approximately 102.27 nautical miles (189.4 kilometers) off the Coast of Guyana and covers an area of 136.8 square nautical miles (469.3 square kilometer); bounded by the following coordinates:
