On *October 15, 2023 ExxonMobil Guyana Limited (EMGL)* will continue Deep Water Development operations within the Yellowtail, Liza and Payara fields within **Stabroek Block** of Guyana's Exclusive Economic Zone.

This exercise is scheduled to conclude on **November 20, 2023,** and will incorporate the use of *MSV Normand Samson* which will display the international signal for vessel engaged in such activity.

The area is situated approximately 107.4 and 97.1 nautical miles (198.9 and 179.8 kilometers) off the Coast of Guyana, and covers an area of 136.8 and 25.4 square nautical miles (87.4 and 469.3 square kilometer); bounded by the following coordinates:
