**OFFSHORE GUYANA**

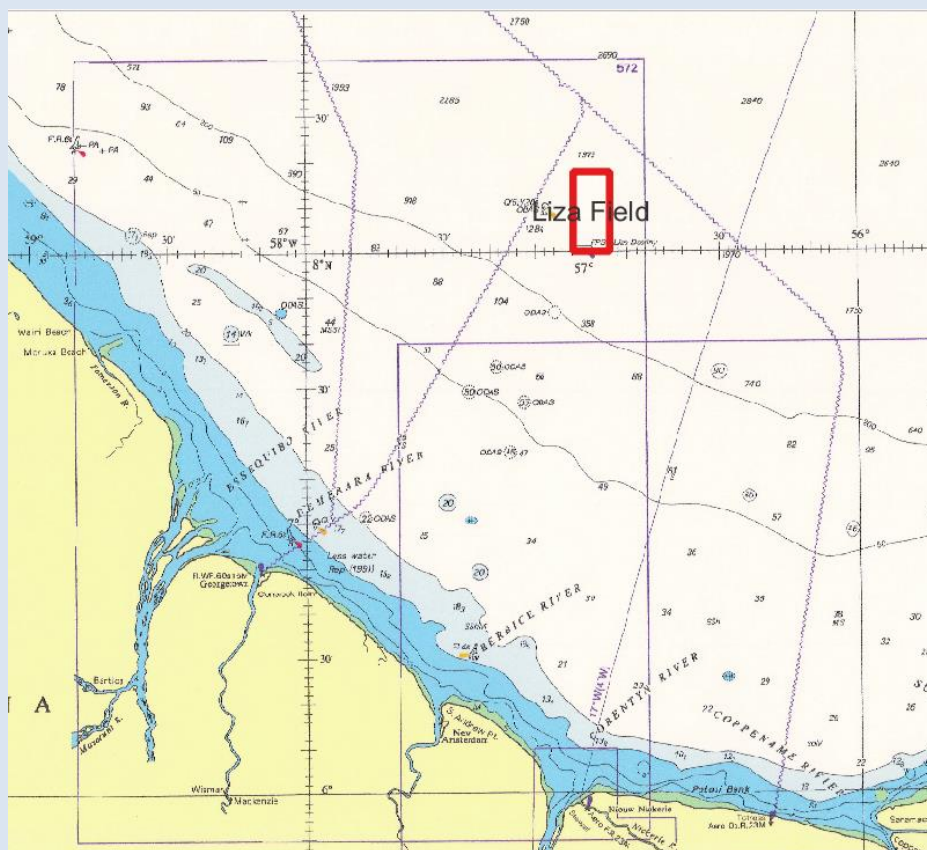
On *January 01, 2024 ExxonMobil Guyana Limited (EMGL)* will continue Deep Water Development operations in Liza Field within the **Stabroek Block** of Guyana's Exclusive Economic Zone.

This exercise is scheduled to conclude on **December 31, 2024** and will incorporate the use of the under mentioned vessels which will display the international signal for vessels engaged in such activities:

- **OSV Seacor Amazon**
- **FSV Emily Day McCall**
- **FSV Michael Crombie McCall**

The developmental area is situated approximately 102.27 nautical miles (189.4 kilometers) off the Coast of Guyana, and covers an area of 136.8 square nautical miles (469.3 square kilometer); bounded by the following coordinates:
