**NOTICE TO MARINERS**

**No. 049 (2024) Guyana**

**OFFSHORE GUYANA**

*On April 01, 2024, ExxonMobil Guyana Limited (EMGL)* will continue with pipe laying activities from off the West Coast of Demerara to Offshore within Guyana’s Exclusive Economic Zone.

This exercise is schedule to conclude on **September 30, 2024** and will incorporate the use of the *Pipe Laying Vessel Seven Borealis* which will display the international signal for vessel engaged in such activity.

The pipe laying area is situated approximately 23.92 nautical miles (44.75 kilometers) off the Coast of Guyana and covers an area of 24.60 square nautical miles (84.39 square kilometers); bounded by the following coordinates:

All mariners are required to stay clear of this vessel and navigate with extreme caution when in the vicinity.

Vessels are therefore prohibited from anchoring in close proximity to these pipes and anchoring would be allowed at a minimum distance of **300 meters** from the pipe position when the vessel rides on her anchor.

Communication can be made with this vessel or the Georgetown Lighthouse, on VHF Ch. 16.
