**APPROACHES TO DEMERARA RIVER**

The Maritime Administration Department (MARAD) wishes to advise that dredging and reclamation activities will continue in the vicinity of BOSAI Mineral Group wharf facility, **Upper Demerara River**.

This exercise is scheduled to conclude on **September 12, 2024**, and will incorporate the use of **TSHD Parana** which will display the international signal for vessel engaged in such activity.

The dredging area covers an area of 0.19 square nautical miles (0.32 square kilometer); bounded by the following coordinates:
