DEMERARA RIVER

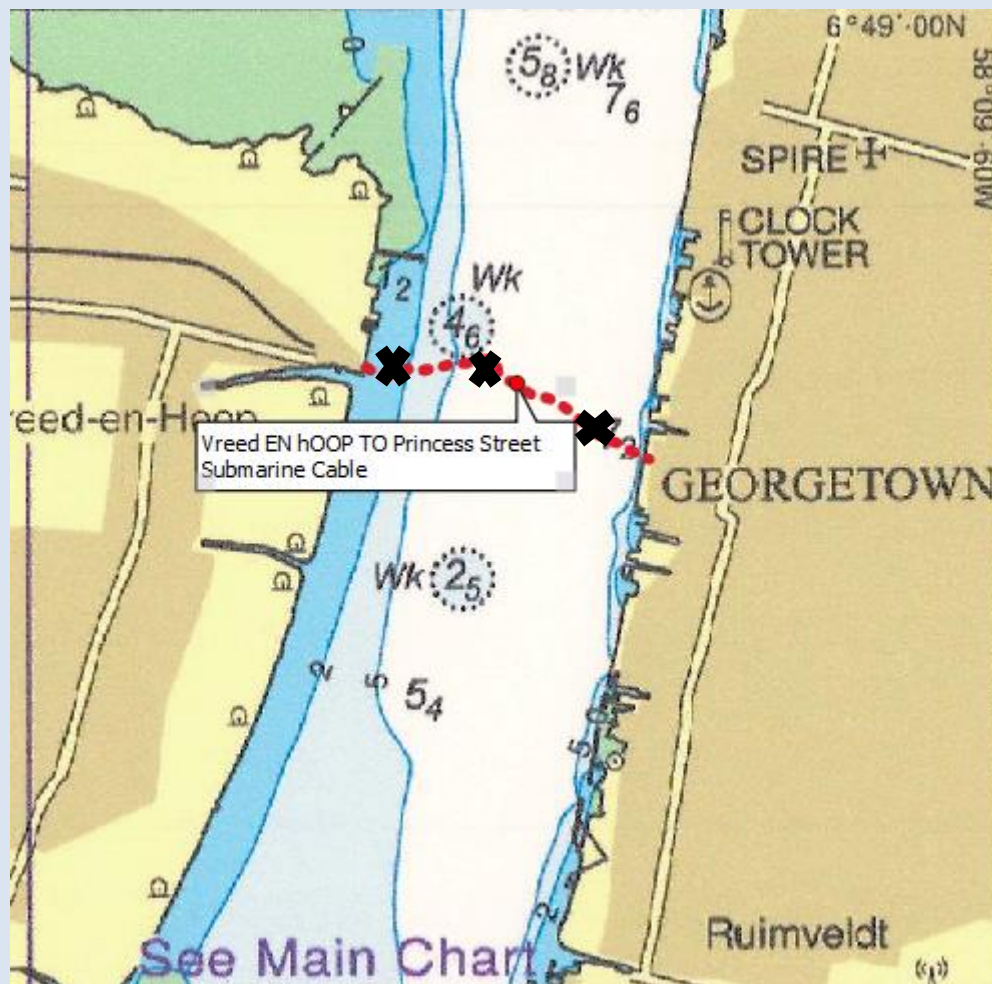
The *Maritime Administration Department (MARAD)* hereby notifies all vessels operating and/ or within the Harbour of Georgetown, that the Guyana Power & Light Company (**GPL**) will be permanently removing the two submarine power cables laid at GPL Vreed en Hoop to Princess Street Outfalls and Vriesland to Craig.

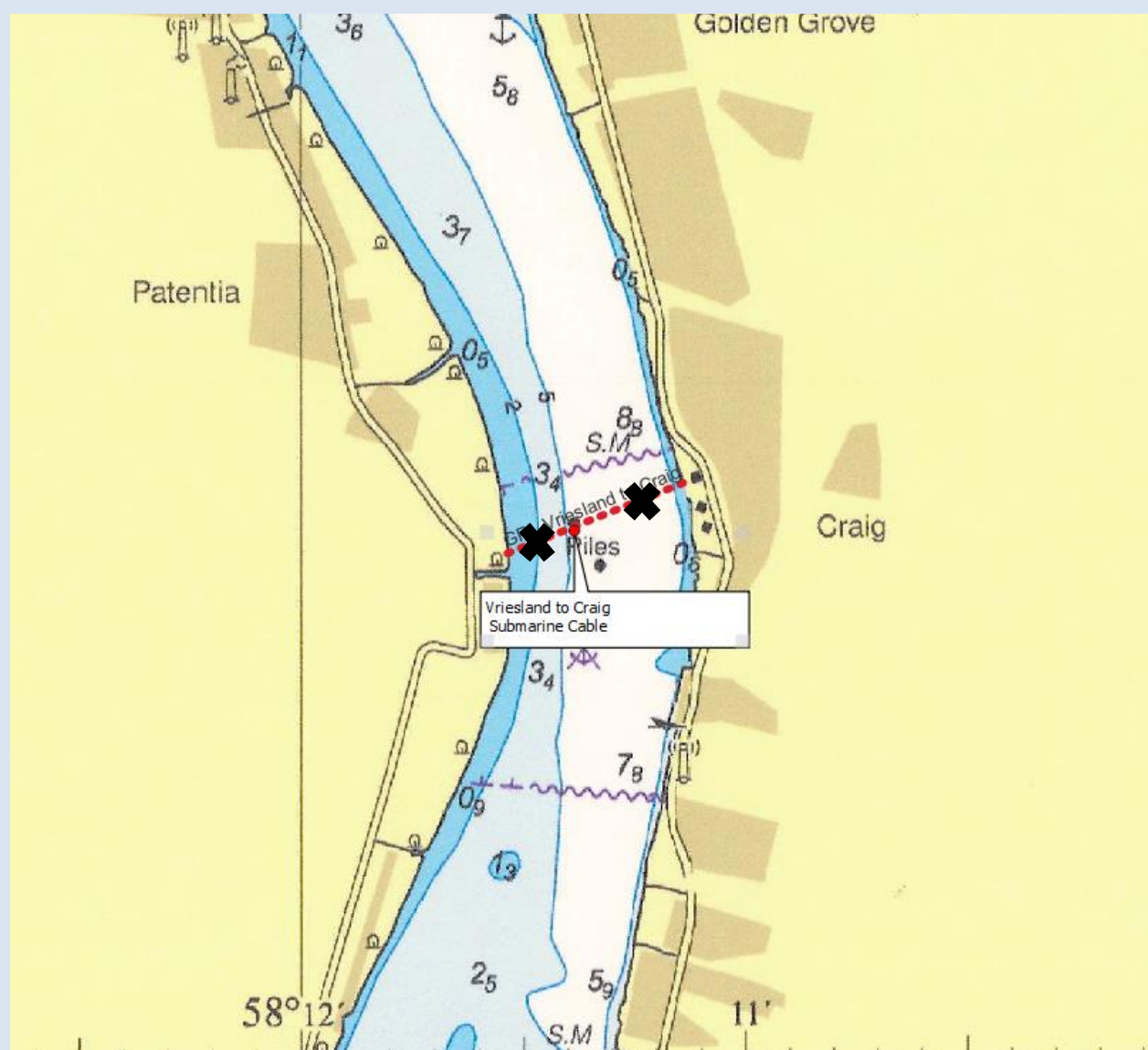
This operation is scheduled to conclude on **October 16, 2024**, and will incorporate the use of **MV Lynx** and **DB T'ZC 333** that would display the international signal for vessels engaged in such activities:
