**OFFSHORE GUYANA**

*ExxonMobil Guyana Limited (EMGL)* will continue Deep Water Development operations within the Yellowtail, Liza, Payara and Uaru 1 & 2 fields within **Stabroek Block** of Guyana's Exclusive Economic Zone.

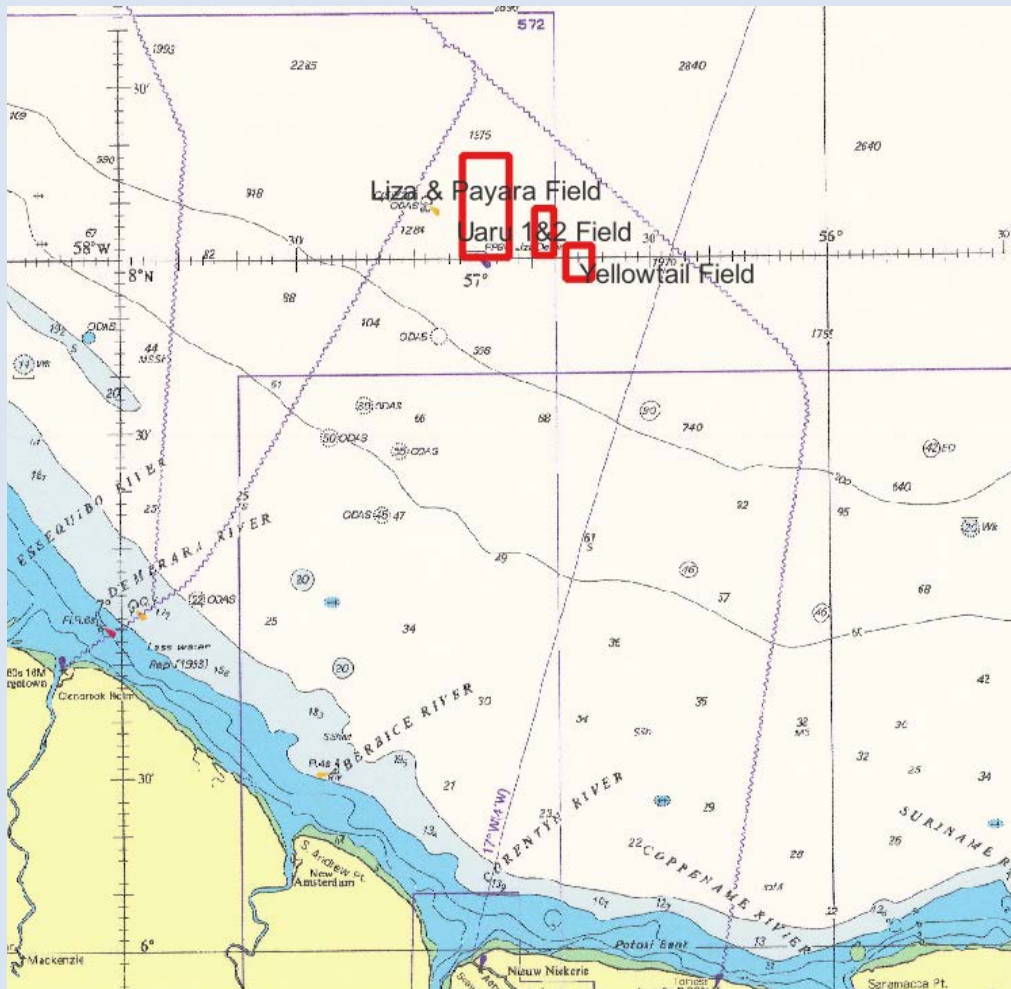
This exercise is scheduled to conclude on **December 31, 2024**, and will incorporate the use of *PSV Knock Out P* which will display the international signal for vessel engaged in such activity.

The areas are situated approximately 97.1, 105.6, and 107.4 nautical miles (198.9, 179.8 and 195.7 kilometers) off the Coast of Guyana, and covers an area of 25.4, 136.8 and 25.8 square nautical miles (87.4, 469.3 and 88.6 square kilometer); bounded by the following coordinates:
