OFFSHORE GUYANA

On March 20, 2025 ExxonMobil Guyana Limited (EMGL) will continue Tug assistance activities for the Floating Production and Storage and Offloading (FPSO) vessels *Liza Destiny*, *Liza Unity* and *Prosperity* within the Liza Field of the **Stabroek Block** of the Guyana’s Exclusive Economic Zone.

This exercise is scheduled to conclude on **December 31, 2025**, and will incorporate the use of *AHT Alice Prima* which will display the international signal for vessels engaged in such activity.

The areas are situated approximately 97.1 nautical miles (179.8 kilometers) off the Coast of Guyana, and covers an area of 136.8 square nautical miles (469.3 square kilometer); bounded by the following coordinates:
