OFFSHORE GUYANA

ExxonMobil Guyana Limited (EMGL) will continue Support Activities within the Yellowtail, Liza and Payara fields within **Stabroek Block** of Guyana’s Exclusive Economic Zone.

This exercise is scheduled to conclude on **December 31, 2025** and will incorporate the use of ***AHT SL Marabou and AHT SL Griffin*** which will display the international signal for vessels engaged in such activities.

The areas are situated approximately 107.4 and 97.1 nautical miles (198.9 and 179.8 kilometers) off the Coast of Guyana, and covers an area of 25.4 and 136.8 square nautical miles (87.4 and 469.3 square kilometer); bounded by the following coordinates:
