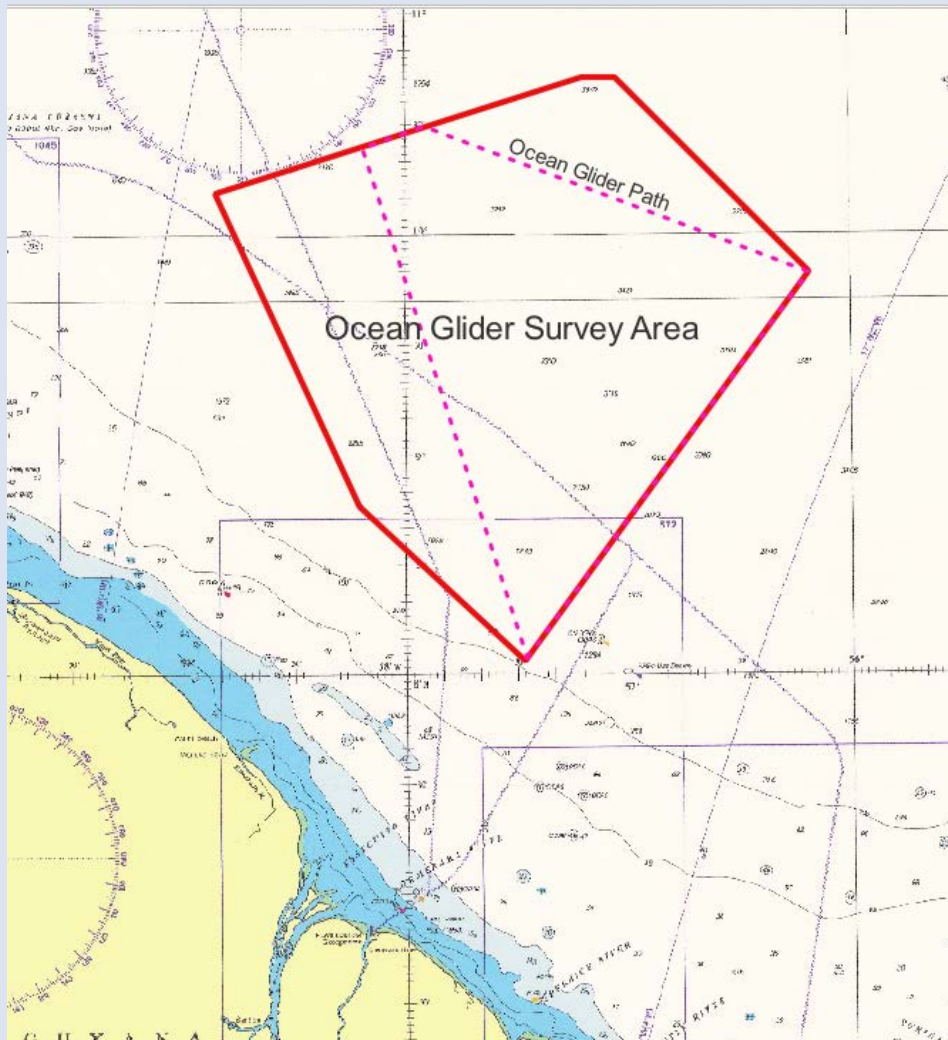
OFFSHORE GUYANA

Maritime Administration Department (MARAD) wishes to inform that the *Caribbean Institute for Meteorology and Hydrology (CIMH)* has commenced a research and data collection activity using the *in-situ* marine data collection platform (Ocean Glider) within Guyana’s Exclusive Economic Zone.

This exercise is scheduled to conclude on **October 06, 2025**.

The survey area is situated approximately 84.23 nautical miles (156.01 kilometers) from the coast of Guyana, and covers an area of 3895.57 square nautical miles (7660.48 square kilometers), bounded by the following coordinates:

All mariners are required to stay clear of this sub-surface unit and navigate with extreme caution when in the vicinity, as it would be surfacing at various times during the surveys.
