
APPROACHES TO DEMERARA RIVER

The Maritime Administration Department (MARAD) wishes to advise that surveying activities will commence in the vicinity of the Demerara Main Ship Channel and off the West Coast of Demerara in the vicinity of **Plantation Best**.

This exercise is scheduled to conclude on **December 31, 2026**, and will incorporate the use of the ***AHT DN 87*** and ***Work Boat TELESTO*** which will display the international signal for vessel engaged in such activity.

The survey area covers an area of 10.19 square nautical miles (34.96 square kilometers); bounded by the following coordinates:
