OFFSHORE GUYANA

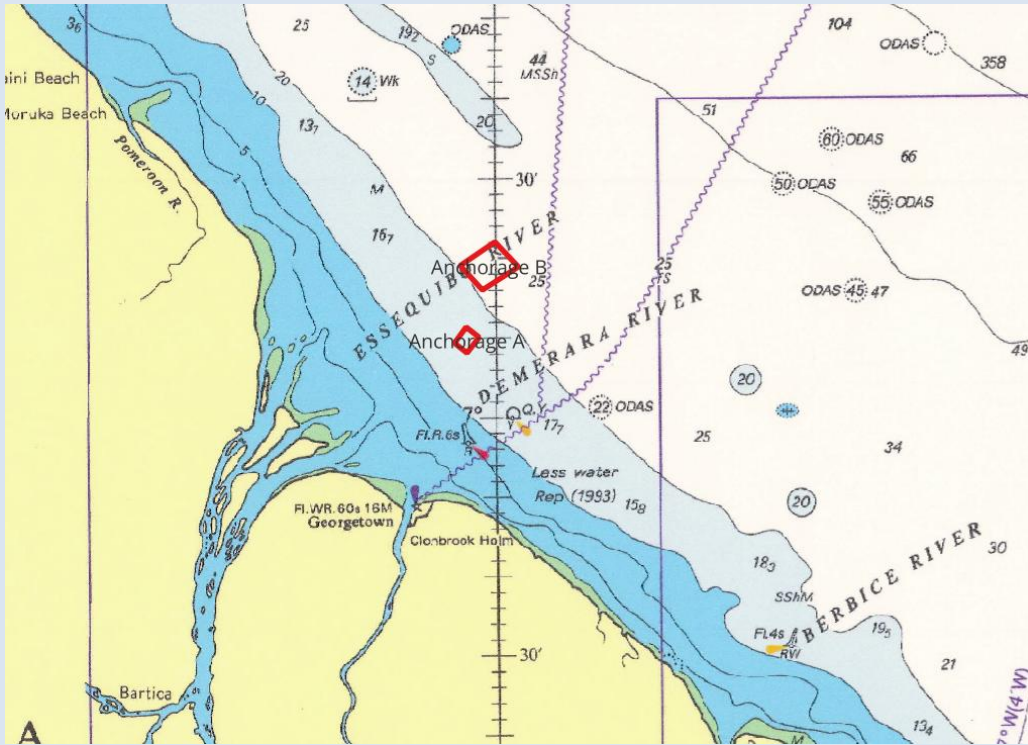
The Maritime Administration Department (MARAD) wishes to advise that Trans-Shipments Activities will be conducted in the **Anchorage A** and **Anchorage B** Areas Offshore Guyana.

This exercise will conclude on **December 31, 2026**, and will incorporate the use of **BG Mission and BG Brother** which will display the international signal for vessel engaged in such activity.

The Trans-Shipments area is situated approximately 19.7 and 27.7 nautical miles (36.5 and 51.4 kilometers) off the Coast of Guyana and covers an area of 04.8 and 21.2 square nautical miles (16.5 and 72.6 square kilometers); bounded by the following coordinates:
